

First Generation

1. **Michael? FOLEY** was born in ABT 1800S in possibly Breanamore, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon. The Foley family came from the townland of Breanamore (sometimes spelled Brenamore) in the parish of Castlerea, Co. Roscommon. The farthest back we can trace the Foleys is to Michael, the father of Anne below. We are only assuming that her father's name was Michael because in Griffith's Valuation (carried out in 1857 and 1858 for Roscommon), the only record for a Foley in Breanamore is for a Michael. In the 1901 census, there is no return for any Foley family in Breanamore.

It is thought that Anne's father was a pig exporter.

It is possible that Anne's mother's name was Bridget Doherty because a baptismal record has been located on the FamilySearch website for an Ann Foley of Tibohine, Co. Roscommon (not far from Castlerea), daughter of Michael Foley and Bridget Doherty, who was christened on 4 May 1839 in Loughglynn. This date ties in with the year of birth of 1839 previously provided to me by family sources for our Anne Foley.

According to a family source, a Foley headstone in Clonard (also spelled Cloonard) Cemetery in Co. Roscommon is the burial place of Anne's father. The same source has told me that Anne's father died in Yorkshire, England (I do not know if this information appears on the headstone). If Anne's father was a pig exporter then I suppose it is possible that he may have done some travelling to Yorkshire. However, I have not yet managed to visit Clonard/Cloonard Cemetery, and, as I have no more information on Anne's father, I am unable to research this further at the moment. If anyone is visiting this cemetery in the near future and has time to search for the Foley grave I would be very grateful if you could send me details of the headstone inscription by emailing HelensFamilyTrees@gmail.com. Thank you.

The Foley surname comes from the Irish surname 'Ó Foghladha', from 'foghlaidh' meaning 'pirate' or 'marauder'. The name originated in Co. Waterford and from there spread to counties Cork and Kerry. The name is most common now in these three counties, although it is numerous generally throughout the southern half of the country. Michael? FOLEY and 'UNKNOWN' were married.

'UNKNOWN' was born (date unknown).

Michael? FOLEY and 'UNKNOWN' had the following child:

- +2 i **Anne FOLEY**, born 1839, Breanamore, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon; married Thomas GORDON, abt 1857; died 26 Feb 1885, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon.

Second Generation

2. **Anne FOLEY** (Michael?-1) was born in 1839 in Breanamore, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon. She died on 26 Feb 1885 at the age of 46 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. It is believed that Anne's father was a pig exporter.

It is also thought that Anne was an only daughter. She was possibly an only child because her father left the family farm to Anne and her husband, Thomas. However, as a result of a government act of the time (details unknown), the farm was distributed amongst others.

Anne died of heart disease at the age of about 45. Her death record tells us that cause of death was 'morbus

cordis' that had lasted eight weeks. The youngest of her 13 surviving children was only four years old. Anne FOLEY and Thomas GORDON were married about 1857.



Thomas GORDON, son of Cormac or Thomas GORDON and Ann HUNT, was born in 1821 in probably Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 15 Nov 1821 in Loughglynn, Co. Roscommon. He died on 23 Mar 1901 at the age of 80 in probably Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. Sponsors at Thomas's baptism were Patrick Gordon and Mary Hunt.


According to the marriage notice in The Auckland Star newspaper of his eldest son, Michael, Thomas's address (in early 1889) is given as Roughwood Lodge, Castlerea, Co. Roscommon. Perhaps Roughwood Lodge was the house inherited by Thomas and his wife, Anne (née Foley), from Anne's father.

Thomas left his estate, worth £456 5s to his son-in-law, William Clarke (husband of Thomas's daughter Kathleen).

Thomas GORDON and Anne FOLEY had the following children:

- +3 i **Catherine (Kathleen) J. GORDON**, born 15 Apr 1858, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married William CLARKE, 22 Aug 1883, Fairymount Church; died 20 Feb 1927, Dublin.
- +4 ii **Bridget (Bea) GORDON**, born 7 Jun 1859, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married Laurence O'HARA, 18 Jul 1886, Fairymount Church; died 5 Sep 1949, Clegna, Cootehall, Boyle, Co. Roscommon.
- +5 iii **Michael John GORDON**, born May 1861, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married Sarah Bridget MURPHY, 3 Feb 1889, St. Benedict's Church, Newton, Auckland; died 26 Jun 1938, probably Paeroa, New Zealand.
- 6 iv **Mary GORDON** was born on 9 Jul 1862 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She died on 8 Jun 1924 at the age of 61 in London. Mary was a sister in the order of la Sainte-Union des Sacrés-Cœurs, working initially at Our Lady's Bower in Athlone, Co. Westmeath and later at the order's convent on Highgate Road in Camden, London, where she died. Mary's name in religion was Sr. M. Regis.
- 7 v **Anne (Annie) GORDON** was born on 5 Feb 1865 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 9 Feb 1865 in Loughglynn, Co. Roscommon. Annie entered the convent but it is not known what order she joined. She worked in Sligo initially and later served in convents in Central America. Unfortunately we have no further information on Annie.
- 8 vi **Patrick (Pat) GORDON** was born on 25 Nov 1866 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He died about 1899 at the age of 33 in Liverpool. According to one family source, Pat went to Australia in 1895. According to another, he worked for the railroad in the Liverpool area and died around 1899 when only in his thirties. Perhaps he did both. I was also told that Patrick never married.

However, a Cormick (sic) Gordon was born to a Patrick Gordon and a Hanna M. Powell in West Derby registration district in 1913. Could Cormick has been a child of our Patrick above? I wonder this because, so far, every Cormac/Cormack/Cormick Gordon I have ever come across in the course of my research has been a member of my husband's extended Gordon family. Cormick appears to have married Elizabeth E. Staton in Crosby registration district in 1941 and they had at least four children. He lived at 55 Harrington Road, Formby, Merseyside

- and he died on 15 August 1980.
- +9 vii **Elizabeth (Lizzie) Ellen GORDON**, born 23 Jul 1868, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married John MCDONNELL, 28 Apr 1892, Fairymount Church; died 3 Dec 1955, 19 Herbert St., Dublin.
- +10 viii **Cormac GORDON**, born 26 Feb 1870, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married Mary MORAHAN, 7 Feb 1906, Jamestown, Co. Leitrim; died 13 Sep 1939, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon.
- 11 ix **Jane (Jennie) GORDON** was born on 17 Jun 1871 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She died on 1 Dec 1964 at the age of 93 in Dublin. She was buried in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin. Jennie, who never married, was a domestic science teacher and taught in Sligo for a number of years. She retired to Dublin where she lived at 24 Trees Road in Mount Merrion.
- 
- 12 x **Theresa (Tillie) GORDON** was born on 10 Dec 1873 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 17 Dec 1875 in possibly Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She died on 12 Feb 1965 at the age of 91. Theresa was buried in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin. Tillie was a nurse. She worked in Panama where she travelled by mule and delivered babies. She also nursed in Guatemala and later worked in New York. There is a record of Tillie arriving in New Orleans from Cristóbal, Panama in December 1917. The ship manifest tells us that Tilly's last residence was Guatemala City, Guatemala.
- Another travel record located for Tillie relates to her arrival by ship in New York from Ireland on 20 October 1929. She would have been 55 years of age at this time. Surprisingly, on the ship manifest her occupation is "Domestic" rather than nurse.
- Tillie, who never married, returned to live in Ireland after her retirement.
- Apparently Tillie and her sister Jennie, who had been close, had a falling out and their relationship was poor thereafter. According to a family source both were "strong-willed" women.
- 13 xi **Martha GORDON** was born in 1875 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She died in 1877 at the age of 2. According to records as transcribed by the Co. Roscommon Heritage and Genealogy Company, a Martina Gordon (born to Thomas Gordon and Anne Foley) was baptised on 18 February 1877 in Fairymount; a Thomas Gordon (also born to Thomas Gordon and Anne Foley), born 12 February 1877, was baptised on 7 (sic) February 1877 in Fairymount. Was there a transcription error? Or were Martina/Martha and Thomas twins? Or is the information provided by the family correct, i.e., Martha was born in 1875 and Thomas was born in 1877?
- +14 xii **Thomas (Tom) Francis GORDON**, born 19 Jan 1877, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married Margaret BLAKELEY, 4 Jul 1904, Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Bernard's Church, Kingsley Road, Toxteth Park, Liverpool; died 4 Jan 1948, Birkenhead, Cheshire.
- +15 xiii **John GORDON**, born abt 10 Jul 1879, Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon; married

'UNKNOWN', U.S.; died 1948 (NOT VERIFIED), California.

- 16 xiv **Emma (Sr. Jerome) GORDON** was born on 1 Nov 1881 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She died on 19 Jan 1968 at the age of 86 in Dublin. She was buried in Sisters of Charity convent cemetery, Donnybrook, Dublin. Emma, who may also have been known as Emily, entered the convent in 1909, becoming Sr. Jerome. A member of the Sisters of Charity order, she worked in Dublin at Linden Convalescent Home and St. Vincent's Hospital.



According to the Irish Genealogy website, Sr. Jerome was born on 1 November 1881 but her headstone says 1882. She is buried in the same plot as her first cousin once removed Mother Francis Raphael (born Clare) Gordon.

- 17 xv **James Joseph GORDON** was born on 5 Feb 1883 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 8 Apr 1883 in possibly Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He died on 8 Aug 1883 at the age of 0. It is believed that James of whooping cough.
- 18 xvi **William Martin GORDON** was born on 5 Feb 1883 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 8 Apr 1883 in possibly Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He died on 1 Aug 1883 at the age of 0. It is believed that William of whooping cough.

Third Generation

3. **Catherine (Kathleen) J. GORDON** (Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born on 15 Apr 1858 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 18 Apr 1858 in Loughglynn, Co. Roscommon. She died on 20 Feb 1927 at the age of 68 in Dublin. Catherine was buried in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin. Catherine (Kathleen) J. GORDON and William CLARKE were married on 22 Aug 1883 in Fairymount Church.

William CLARKE, son of Thomas CLARKE, was born about 1851 in Co. Roscommon. He died on 25 Jul 1928 at the age of 77 in 97 Lower Leeson St., Dublin. He was buried in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin. William was a farmer and a justice of the peace. He also owned and operated a corn mill in Castlemore, Co. Mayo (near Ballaghaderreen). He and Kathleen lived in Castlemore House in Castlemore for many years before moving (sometime after the 1911 census, possibly as late as the 1920s) to Dublin where they lived at 6 Elgin Road in Ballsbridge.

According to the 1911 census, William and Kathleen had been married for 27 years and had nine children born alive, eight of whom were alive at the time of the census (Gordon having died in 1897).

The address where William died, 97 Lower Leeson St. in Dublin, appears to have been a nursing home at the time. His home address was still 6 Elgin Road. William died of "appendicitis with peritonitis", 17 months after the death of Kathleen.

William CLARKE and Catherine (Kathleen) J. GORDON had the following children:

- 19 i **Thomas Gordon (Gordon) CLARKE** was born on 2 Jun 1884 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. He was christened on 28 Dec 1884 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. He died on 12 Jun 1897 at the age of 13 in Co. Sligo or Co. Mayo. I have been told that Gordon died in a drowning accident while at boarding school in Co. Sligo. However, his death record says Gordon died of a cerebral haemorrhage in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. He had just turned 13.

- John Joseph CLARKE**, born 31 Jul 1885, Castlemore, Co. Mayo; married Ellen (Nellie) 'UNKNOWN', bef Sep 1939; died 1975, probably England.
- +21 iii **Herbert Eustace (Bertie) CLARKE**, born 24 Apr 1887, Castlemore, Co. Mayo; married Aidita (Ada) Clare RICKARDS, 1913, Sydney, Australia; died 28 Jun 1945, 400 Chapel Road, Bankstown, New South Wales, Australia.
- 22 iv **Anne Clare CLARKE** was born about 9 Dec 1888 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. She was christened on 9 Dec 1888 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. She died on 12 Mar 1926 at the age of 37 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. Anne, who never married, died at the age of 37 of pneumonia.
- +23 v **Gertrude (Gertie) M. CLARKE**, born 16 Nov 1890, Castlemore, Co. Mayo; died abt 1960, England.
- 24 vi **Mary (May) Christina CLARKE** was born on 17 Apr 1892 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. She was christened on 7 May 1892 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. She died in 1981 at the age of 89 in Brighton, Sussex. May was a doctor and lived in England. She never married.
- 25 vii **Kathleen CLARKE** was born on 23 Jun 1895 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. She died in 1987 at the age of 92 in England. Kathleen was a nurse and lived in the south of England. From the 1939 Register we know she was working at the time as a nurse in the household of retired colonel George May of Rockingham, Andover Road, Winchester, Hampshire.
- +26 viii **Margaret (Rita) Mary CLARKE**, born 13 Jun 1897, Castlemore, Co. Mayo; married Andrew MCDONALD, 1929, Perth, Western Australia; died 1972, Perth, Western Australia.
- 27 ix **Edith (Edie, Nuala) CLARKE** was born on 14 Jan 1899 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. She was christened on 20 Jan 1899 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. She died possibly 1989 at the age of 90 in Hampshire, England. Edie was also called Nuala, and in fact insisted on being called Nuala in her latter years. She lived in England and never married.

4. **Bridget (Bea) GORDON** (Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born on 7 Jun 1859 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 11 Jun 1859 in Loughglynn, Co. Roscommon. She died on 5 Sep 1949 at the age of 90 in Clegna, Cootehall, Boyle, Co. Roscommon. Bridget was buried on 7 Sep 1949 in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin (grave OH 71.5, St. Bridget's). There is a record in the LDS Vital Records Index for the christening in Loughglynn of a Bridget Gordon, daughter of Thomas Gordon and Anne Foley. The date of the christening ties in with the date of birth provided by the family (June 1859) and not with the information on Bea in the 1901 census which indicates that she was born about 1865.

Bea and her husband, Laurence, lived in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. Bea died at the age of 90, outliving her husband, Laurence, by 21 years. Bridget (Bea) GORDON and Laurence O'HARA were married on 18 Jul 1886 in Fairymount Church.

Laurence O'HARA, son of Laurence O'HARA and Eleanor (Ellen) MEEHAN, was born about 24 Sep 1860 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 26 Sep 1860. He died on 12 Jan 1928 at the age of 67 in Dublin. Laurence was buried on 14 Jan 1928 in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin (grave OH 71.5 St. Bridget's). The O'Hara family is twice connected to another family being researched, i.e., the Gordon family of Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. Laurence married Bridget Gordon; and Mary Morahan, a niece of Laurence's, married Bridget's younger brother, Cormac.

It is believed that Laurence spent a number of years in Colorado as a young man.

Laurence died of heart failure at St. Vincent's Hospital in Dublin.

In 1914 a Laurence O'Hara, a farmer and rate collector from Clegna, was charged with the murder of a Patrick Farry of Moigh, Co. Roscommon. Mr. Farry was a member of the Carrick-on-Shannon District Council and chairman of the Knockvicar Creamery Society, of which Mr. O'Hara had been secretary at one time. It seems that on the evening of 26 November 1914 Mr. Farry received a beating from Mr. O'Hara over £10 or £12 which Mr. O'Hara said Mr. Farry owed him from the time he was secretary of the Creamery Society (a dispute which apparently had already been dealt with in the Dublin courts). Mr. Farry lost consciousness as a result of the beating and woke up in the early hours of the following morning covered in blood. He died three weeks later, on 18 December, and Mr. O'Hara was charged with murder. It was subsequently determined by a panel of medical professionals that Mr. Farry's death was due to pulmonary tuberculosis and was not related to the beating. Mr. O'Hara was thereby acquitted. Could this Laurence O'Hara have been our Laurence above?

Laurence O'HARA and Bridget (Bea) GORDON had the following children:

- 28 i **John Gordon O'HARA** was born about 1 Nov 1887 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 1 Nov 1887 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He died on 2 Jul 1908 at the age of 20 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. John died in a drowning accident at the age of 20. His body was found in a river in Clegna on 2 July 1908.
- +29 ii **Evelyn (Eva) Mary O'HARA**, born abt 13 Jul 1889, Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon; married James (Jim) GLYNN, 1 Mar 1916, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon; died 12 Oct 1954, Oxhill, Knockvicar, Co. Roscommon.
- 30 iii **Florence Mary (Sr. Margaret) O'HARA** was born about 14 Mar 1891 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 14 Mar 1891 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She died in 1968 at the age of 77. A Florrie O'Hara, aged 18, who was born in Co. Roscommon is listed as a pupil at the School of Rural and Domestic Economy in Clifden, Co. Galway in the 1911 census. This may be Florence.

Florence entered the convent, becoming Sr. Margaret.
- 31 iv **Joseph O'HARA** was born about 21 May 1892 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 21 May 1892 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He died on 14 Feb 1893 at the age of 0 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. Joseph died of a "cold" at the age of nine months.
- 32 v **Josephine (Sr. Austin Camillus) O'HARA** was born about 19 Nov 1893 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 19 Nov 1893 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She died in 1983 at the age of 90. A Josephine O'Hara, aged 16, who was born in Co. Roscommon is listed as a pupil boarding at the Presentation Convent School, Tuam, Co. Galway in the 1911 census. This may be our Josephine.

Josephine entered the convent, joining the order of the Sisters of Charity. Her name in religion was Sr. Austin Camillus.
- +33 vi **Bridget (Bertha) O'HARA**, born abt 14 Dec 1896, Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon; married Michael B. FOLEY, 26 Jul 1928, Cootehall, Boyle, Co. Roscommon; died 1 Oct 1948, 94 Lower Leeson St., Dublin.
- +34 vii **Mary Catherine (Kathleen) O'HARA**, born 7 Aug 1900, Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon ; married Arthur Peter DOYLE, 24 Jun 1926, Dublin; died 4 Dec 1984, Co. Wexford.
- 35 viii **Laurence O'HARA** was born on 12 Jan 1905 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. He died on 7 Feb 1905 at the age of 0 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. Laurence died of pneumonia at the age of one month.
- +36 ix **Matilda (Maud) Mary O'HARA**, born 28 May 1906, Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon; died 21 Feb 1976, Dublin.

5. **Michael John GORDON** (Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born in May 1861 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He was christened on 19 May 1861 in Loughglynn, Co. Roscommon. He died on 26 Jun 1938 at the age of 77 in probably Paeroa, New Zealand. Michael was buried on 27 Jun 1938 in Pukerimu Cemetery, Paeroa, New Zealand. Michael's relationship with his father, Thomas, was said to have been tempestuous, and it led eventually to Michael's emigration to New Zealand. The story goes that, against his father's wishes, Michael bought a horse that was a highly regarded jumper. This was presumably with his father's money. His father flew into a rage and ordered Michael to return the horse to its former owner. Michael's response was to charge towards a terrified Thomas on the horse and jump over his head. Following this incident Michael decided it was time to leave Kilgarriff. On his next excursion to market, with a horse and cart loaded with produce, he not only sold the produce but also the horse and cart. With the proceeds he made his way to Dublin where he bought a boat ticket to New Zealand. He never returned to Ireland.

Michael was a keen and very skilled horseman and he continued to work with horses when he went to New Zealand. He worked initially as an ostler and stable hand in Auckland and much later owned a magnificent set of drays which he used in his haulage business in Paeroa. He also maintained his interest in horse-racing for the rest of his life.

Michael and his wife, Sarah, remained in Auckland for a couple of years after their marriage but then work became scarce owing to an economic recession and Michael and Sarah moved to Melbourne, Australia with their son Alfred. Their second child, Albert (Joe) was born in Melbourne. After five years in Melbourne the family returned to New Zealand. The economy was improving and Michael was able to set up his haulage business. He and Sarah and their family settled in Paeroa.

Michael is buried alongside Sarah, in Section ROC (Roman Catholic?), Plot 563 in Pukerimu Cemetery, Paeroa.

It is said that, throughout his life, Michael maintained was of the opinion that, as the eldest son, he had a legitimate right to the family farm back in Ireland. This is probably why his son Joe, while on leave in Ireland during service in World War I, apparently suggested to his (hospitable) cousins that the farm was by rights his father's. Joe's relatives politely changed the subject, poured him more whiskey, and Joe got nowhere.

Note: There is a record in the LDS Vital Records Index for the christening in Loughglynn of a Michael Gordon, son of Thomas Gordon and Anne Foley. The date of the christening (19 May 1861) ties in roughly with the date of birth provided by the family (Sep 1860). Michael John GORDON and Sarah Bridget MURPHY were married on 3 Feb 1889 in St. Benedict's Church, Newton, Auckland.



Sarah Bridget MURPHY, daughter of James MURPHY and Johanna CRONIN, was born in 1866 in Arch Hill, Auckland. She died on 10 Nov 1914 at the age of 48 in probably Paeroa, New Zealand. She was buried on 12 Nov 1914 in Pukerimu Cemetery, Paeroa, New Zealand. Sarah was only 48 years of age when she died. She is buried in Section ROC, Plot 563 of Pukerimu Cemetery in Paeroa.

Michael John GORDON and Sarah Bridget MURPHY had the following children:

- +37 i **Alfred James GORDON**, born abt 1891, New Zealand; married Elizabeth (Lizzie) FALLON, 1916; died 21 Nov 1918.
- +38 ii **Albert Joseph (Joe) GORDON**, born 22 Aug 1893, West Melbourne, Australia; died 1972, probably Auckland, New Zealand.
- +39 iii **Monica (Mona) Mary GORDON**, born abt 1895, New Zealand; married William (Bill) BAIN, 1915; died 25 Feb 1984.
- 40 iv **Francis (Frank) GORDON** was born in 1900 in New Zealand. He died in 1976 at the age of 76. Frank, who never married, suffered from ill health throughout his life.

She died of heart failure at the age of 87. Elizabeth (Lizzie) Ellen GORDON and John MCDONNELL were married on 28 Apr 1892 in Fairymount Church. Lizzie's name was Mary Elizabeth on her marriage certificate.

John MCDONNELL, son of Alexander MCDONNELL and Ellen KENNY, was born about 1860 in Kilmovee, Co. Mayo. He died in Dec 1922 at the age of 62. He was buried in Dominican Abbey Monastery, Orlar, Kilmovee, Co. Mayo. John and Lizzie lived in Woodlawn, Kilmovee.

John died following a hernia operation in Dublin.

John MCDONNELL and Elizabeth (Lizzie) Ellen GORDON had the following children:

Alex died of blood poisoning at the age of 27 after accidentally cutting his arm with a scythe.

She died on 10 Jun 1976 at the age of 81 in Dublin. Anne was buried on 12 Jun 1976 in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin (grave OH 70.5, St. Bridget's). Annie was a nurse and lived in London before returning to Ireland. She lived at 102 Morehampton Road, Donnybrook, Dublin with her sisters, Eva and Emma.

- Annie never married. She died of heart failure at St. Vincent's Nursing Home in Dublin aged 81.

- 48 vii **Emma MCDONNELL** was born on 11 May 1910 in Corgarriff, Kilmovee, Co. Mayo. She died on 2 May 1982 at the age of 71 in Dublin. She was buried on 4 May 1982 in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin (grave OH 70.5, St. Bridget's). Emma was a matron in Clongowes Wood College, Co. Kildare (we know she was at Clongowes in the 1950s) and later in St. Vincent's Hospital, Dublin (in the 1960s and perhaps later) where there is a library named after her. she She never married. She and her sisters, Annie and Eva, shared a home for many years at 102 Morehampton Road, Donnybrook, Dublin.
- Emma died of heart failure at St. Vincent's Hospital, Dublin aged 72.
- 49 viii **Eva MCDONNELL** was born on 16 Apr 1916 in Corgarriff, Kilmovee, Co. Mayo. She died on 6 Oct 2009 at the age of 93 in Foxford, Co. Mayo. She was buried in Urlaur New Cemetery, Kilmovee, Co. Mayo. Eva was a caterer in Holles Street Hospital in Dublin. She never married. She and her sisters Annie and Emma lived together for many years in their home at 102 Morehampton Road, Donnybrook, Dublin.

In 2002 Eva moved to a nursing home in Foxford, Co. Mayo where she died seven years later.



10. **Cormac GORDON** (Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born on 26 Feb 1870 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He died on 13 Sep 1939 at the age of 69 in Kilgarriff, Fairymount, Co. Roscommon. He was buried on 15 Sep 1939 in Fairymount Cemetery, Co. Roscommon. Cormac ran the Gordon family farm in Kilgarriff.

Cormac died following a stroke ("hemiplegia (14 days)" and "cardiac failure", as specified on his death record). Cormac GORDON and Mary MORAHAN were married on 7 Feb 1906 in Jamestown, Co. Leitrim.


Mary MORAHAN, daughter of Owen MORAHAN and Margaret O'HARA, was born about 5 Aug 1877 in Cloonfeacle, Kiltoghert, Carrick-on-Shannon, Co. Leitrim. She was christened on 7 Aug 1877 in Kiltoghert, Carrick-on-Shannon, Co. Leitrim. She died on 20 Jan 1932 at the age of 54 in Dublin. Mary was buried in Fairymount Cemetery, Co. Roscommon. Sponsors at Mary's baptism were John Morahan and Jane Murray.

Witnesses to Mary's marriage to Cormac Gordon were John Gordon and Belinda Morahan. Presumably Belinda

was Mary's sister, Linda.

Mary died in St. Vincent's Hospital in Dublin following complications from a hernia operation carried out at either St. Vincents' or the hospital in Castlerea, Co. Roscommon. The cause of death, according to the death record, was 'strangulated intestinal hernia (5 days)' and 'cardiac failure'.

Having trained at the Munster Institute in Cork, Emma worked for many years as a hotel housekeeper in Dublin. Emma, who never married, died at the age of 101. She is buried with her aunt Lizzie McDonnell (née Gordon) and her first cousins Annie and Emma McDonnell in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin. I am told that this grave is located beside those of other relatives, including Emma's aunts Kathleen Clarke (née Gordon) and Bea O'Hara (née Gordon).

Tom was a dairy keeper (according to his marriage record) and later greengrocer (according to the 1911 census). His address at the time of his marriage (in 1904) was 81 New Ferry Road, New Ferry, Merseyside, and by the time of the 1911 census he was living at 54 Watson St. in Birkenhead. The 1939 Register tells us he was living at the time at 14 Euston Grove, Birkenhead, and at the time of his death in 1948 his address was 47 Clee Hill Road, Prenton, Birkenhead. Thomas (Tom) Francis GORDON and Margaret BLAKELEY were married on 4 Jul 1904 in Our

Lady of Lourdes and St. Bernard's Church, Kingsley Road, Toxteth Park, Liverpool. Witnesses to the marriage were J. Kenny and Anne Sweeney.

Margaret BLAKELEY, daughter of Hezekiah BLAKELEY and Mary KENNY, was born on 17 Nov 1885 in Toxteth Park, Liverpool. She died after 4 Jan 1948 at the age of 62. Margaret's address at the time of her marriage in 1904 was 34 Exe St., Toxteth Park, Liverpool.

Thomas (Tom) Francis GORDON and Margaret BLAKELEY had the following children:

He died in 1948 (NOT VERIFIED) in California. John emigrated to the United States and lived in California. Unfortunately, contact with the family was lost and we have no further information on John, although it is believed he married and had a son.

There is confusion as to John's exact date of birth. According to the family, he was born on 12 June 1878. And according to records as transcribed by the Co. Roscommon Heritage and Genealogy Company, he was born on 2 August 1879 and baptised on 10 July 1879. Very often, the date on a baptismal record is a more accurate indication of a date of birth than the date on an actual birth record. This is because baptisms, which usually took place a day or two after birth, were registered at the time, whereas births were often registered a couple of months after the event, by which time the exact birth date was often forgotten. Another explanation is that John Gordon who was born on 12 June 1878 died as an infant and his parents had another son on 10 July 1879 whom they named John. John GORDON and 'UNKNOWN' were married in U.S..

Ellen (Nellie) 'UNKNOWN' was born on 24 Jan 1903.

John Joseph CLARKE and Ellen (Nellie) 'UNKNOWN' had the following children:

He was christened on 6 May 1887 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. He died on 28 Jun 1945 at the age of 58 in 400 Chapel Road, Bankstown, New South Wales, Australia. Herbert was buried in Catholic Cemetery, Rookwood, New South Wales. Bertie qualified as a doctor in Dublin. He joined the Royal Army Medical Corps and it is known that he worked as a doctor in the London area for a time before moving to Australia. He lived in Leonora, Western Australia for several years, working at the Leonora District Hospital. Electoral Rolls tells us he was resident in Leonora in 1937 but had moved to Bankstown (400 Chapel Road), New South Wales by 1943. Herbert Eustace (Bertie) CLARKE and Aidita (Ada) Clare RICKARDS were married in 1913 in Sydney, Australia.

Aidita (Ada) Clare RICKARDS, daughter of Arthur RICKARDS and Catherine Letitia 'UNKNOWN', was born about 1884. She died on 12 Oct 1981 at the age of 97. She was buried on 20 Oct 1981 in Catholic Cemetery, Rookwood, New South Wales. Ada may have been a nurse.

Herbert Eustace (Bertie) CLARKE and Aidita (Ada) Clare RICKARDS had the following child:

Prior to her marriage she worked in St. Vincent's Hospital in Dublin. She and her husband, Joe, a doctor, later settled in London where Gertie worked in Joe's practice.

Joseph (Joe) P. DOYLE, son of Arthur Joseph DOYLE and Mary Jane 'UNKNOWN', was born on 21 Oct 1890 in probably New Ross, Co. Wexford. He died after 1960 at the age of 70 in London. Joe and his wife, Gertie, met in St. Vincent's Hospital in Dublin where Joe's father was a patient and Gertie was a nurse. Gertie's aunt Sr. Jerome Gordon, who also worked in the hospital, apparently engineered their union: she instructed Gertie to look after Joe's father after Gertie's first cousin Kathleen O'Hara, a previous carer of Joe's father, had married Joe's brother Arthur (a result, it is believed, of another match-making effort by Sr. Jerome).

Joe was a doctor. He and Gertie, who had no children, moved to London. The 1939 Register tells us they were

living at 40 Melbourne Avenue, Ealing at that time.



26. **Margaret (Rita) Mary CLARKE** (Catherine (Kathleen) J. Gordon-3, Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born on 13 Jun 1897 in Castlemore, Co. Mayo. She was christened on 20 Jun 1897 in Ballaghaderreen, Co. Roscommon. She died in 1972 at the age of 75 in Perth, Western Australia. Rita emigrated to Australia. Margaret (Rita) Mary CLARKE and Andrew MCDONALD were married in 1929 in Perth, Western Australia.

Andrew MCDONALD was born in 1883 in Gre Gre, Victoria, Australia. He died in 1972 at the age of 89 in Perth, Western Australia. Andrew's parents were from the Isle of Skye, Scotland. He was a twin. He lived with his wife and daughters on Mertondale sheep station near Leonora, Western Australia, which he managed for many before retiring around 1950.

Andrew MCDONALD and Margaret (Rita) Mary CLARKE had the following children:

James (Jim) GLYNN, son of Patrick GLYNN, died on 26 Jul 2955 in Oxhill, Knockvillar, Co. Roscommon. He was born in Boyle, Co. Roscommon. Jim was from Oxhill, Knockvillar, Boyle, Co. Roscommon, where he and Evelyn lived after their marriage.

Kathleen (Sr. Evelyn) GLYNN was born in 1929 in Knockvicar, Boyle, Co. Roscommon. She died on 7 Mar 2013 at the age of 84 in Cork. Kathleen was a sister in the Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance (OCSO), an enclosed order. According to her obituary in the St. Mary's Abbey newsletter, she inherited musical talent from her mother, Evelyn, and studied in England, obtaining a Licentiate from the Guild Hall of Music, London, and a second Diploma from Trinity College of Music, London. She taught music in England for a time before returning to Ireland in 1957 when she entered the OCSO convent at St. Mary's Abbey, Glencairn, Lismore, Co. Waterford. She made First Profession on 27 December 1959 and Solemn Profession exactly three years later. Known as Sr. Evelyn she spent most of the rest of her life at St. Mary's.

33. **Bridget (Bertha) O'HARA** (Bridget (Bea) Gordon-3, Anne Foley-2, Michael?-1) was born about 14 Dec 1896 in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She was christened on 14 Dec 1896 in Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. She died on 1 Oct 1948 at the age of 51 in 94 Lower Leeson St., Dublin. Bridget was buried on 4 Oct 1948 in Glasnevin Cemetery, Dublin (grave OH 71.5, St. Bridget's). Bertha seems to be listed as Delia Mary in the 1911 census.

She and her husband, Michael, may also have had a daughter named Mary.

Bertha died aged 51 of cancer. Bridget (Bertha) O'HARA and Michael B. FOLEY were married on 26 Jul 1928 in Cootehall, Boyle, Co. Roscommon.

Michael B. FOLEY, son of Michael FOLEY, was born in 1898 in near Boyle, Co. Roscommon. He died on 27 Jul 1970 at the age of 72 in 4 Castlefields, Dungannon. Co. Tyrone. He was buried in St. Patrick's Cemetery, Dungannon. Co. Tyrone. Michael (often known as Barney) was the eldest of nine children. He attended Summerhill College, Co Sligo where he was awarded a County Exhibition Scholarship for his academic achievements. He graduated from University College Galway in 1921 with a civil engineering degree. However, jobs in engineering were scarce in Ireland at that time due to social, political and economic conditions so Michael turned to teaching. He worked as a maths and geography teacher at St. Patrick's Boys' Academy in Dungannon, Co. Tyrone from 1921 until he retired around 1963. He continued working as a substitute teacher following his retirement at both the Boys' Academy and the adjacent Girls' Academy (the two schools later amalgamated).

He and his first wife, Bertha, lived in Clegna, Cootehall, Co. Roscommon. Michael would work in Dungannon during the week and return home at weekends to Clegna. Following his marriage to Phyllis, he settled permanently in Dungannon where he and Phyllis lived at 4 Castlefields.

Michael B. FOLEY and Bridget (Bertha) O'HARA had the following children:

Arthur Peter DOYLE, son of Arthur Joseph DOYLE and Mary Jane 'UNKNOWN', was born about 1891 in New Ross, Co. Wexford. He died on 10 May 1974 at the age of 83. He was buried in St. Stephen's Cemetery, New Ross, Co. Wexford. Arthur and Kathleen met as a result of match-making efforts by Kathleen's aunt Sr. Jerome Gordon. Sr. Jerome worked in St. Vincent's Hospital in Dublin where Arthur's father, also named Arthur, was a patient. Knowing that Arthur senior had eligible sons, she arranged for Kathleen, who was a nurse, to look after him in New Ross when he was discharged from St. Vincent's.

After their marriage, Kathleen and Arthur lived in New Ross, Co. Wexford.

Joe served in France during World War I. From his attestation and other military papers we know that he was 5ft 9ins tall with hazel eyes and a dark complexion. He signed up for military service on 13 May 1917 and, following a period of training in Wanganui, New Zealand, left with his unit for Europe on 13 August, disembarking in Glasgow, Scotland on 2 October. The Auckland Regiment, of which he was a member, arrived in Etaples, France on 8 November 1917. Joe served a total of one year and 289 days overseas and returned to New Zealand in 1919. He was awarded the Overseas Service Medal and the Victory Medal.

There is a story that at point point during his service in Europe, unable to cope with what he experienced, Joe fled to Ireland where he was given refuge by his aunt Sr. Jerome Gordon in St. Vincent's Hospital, Dublin, where she worked. She kept him in the isolation ward which the authorities, when they came looking for him, were prohibited from entering and so Joe avoided arrest.

Another story, which is likely to be linked to to the above, is that when he was on leave during the war he and other soldiers with Irish connections went to Dublin where they were met by relatives and friends who plied them with whiskey and generally showed them great hospitality. Joe's army records show that he was docked some pay for being AWOL for a few days around this time, which may have been why the authorities were looking for him. It is certainly true that Joe's war experiences scarred him motionally. He had been a victim of gas attacks and other horrors and rarely spoke to his family of his war service. However, he had good memories of his brief time in Dublin and always wanted to go back. He returned for his second visit about 50 years later, in the late 1960s.

Joe and his wife, Kathleen, lived in Auckland for the first few years of their marriage before moving to Wellington in the early 1930s. This was during the Great Depression and Joe, who was a carpenter, found himself out of work. Kathleen's widowed father lived in Masterton, about 100km from Wellington, and when work became available at the Masterton Timber Mill in 1935 the family moved in with Kathleen's father. They lived there until the end of 1939 when they moved back to Auckland.

Catherine (Kathleen) Josephine O'TOOLE died in probably Auckland, New Zealand. Kathleen grew up in Masterton, New Zealand.

Tom's emigration was unplanned. The exact circumstances of his departure aren't known but his possible association with Free State government sympathisers (i.e., those who were pro-Treaty) may have led him to flee, even though he himself wasn't known by family to have been a supporter of either the pro- or anti-Treaty camp. In the course of her research, Kathleen Hegarty Thorne, author of *They Put The Flag a-Flyin'*, an account of the Irish War of Independence and the Civil War as they impacted on Co. Roscommon, came across a report of an incident involving a Treaty supporter whose brother appears to have accompanied Tom to the States a few weeks later. According to Kathleen, a Peter Sharkey who was a pro-Treaty activist from Edmondstown (Kilcolman parish), Ballaghadereen, was shot and badly wounded by anti-Treaty forces in September 1922 for apparently not having complied with an order to leave the area. Ellis Island records list Tom and a Bernard Sharkey together, Bernard giving as his nearest relative at home a brother, Peter Sharkey from Tobracken (in Kilcolman parish), Ballaghadereen. This may well have been the Peter Sharkey who was shot, and it may well be that Tom's possible association with him and/or his brother led to his sudden departure. It would be 20 years before Tom would see Ireland again.
